Game Summary  
 Seattle scored 2 touchdowns in 61 seconds to break open a tightly played defensive struggle. Jim Zorn hit Dan Doornink with a 37 yard scoring pass on the first play of the 4th quarter. On the ensuing Pittsburgh drive Kenny easley intercepted a Mark Malone pass and returned it 60 yards for a TD. Easley's score gave the Seahawks a 23-7 lead. The Steelers had more than double the Seahawks total yards but 6 turnovers and a Terry Bradshaw injury were too much to overcome.
