Williams scored four touchdowns (2 rushing, 2 passing) as the Seahawks carved up the Rams. Seattle's defense pitched the shutout limiting Los Angeles to 156 total yards. It went down hill fast for the Rams after the Seahawks grabbed a 7-0 lead when David Lang fumbled the ensuing kickoff on the one yard line. Williams scored his second touchdown of the game one play later and the rout was on.
