

AMERICAN FOOTBALL LEAGUE ROSTER SHEET

1967 SEASON

The players listed below comprise the teams of the 1969 edition of the APBA American Football League. Some of these players performed at more than one position. This listing shows the lineups used most frequently during the 1967 season, upon which the 1969 edition is based. The frequency of their use at each position should be determined by the order in which they are listed at their positions.

PLAYING BOARD CHANGES TO BE OBSERVED WHEN PLAYING AFL TEAMS ONLY

On the Long Pass section of the playing boards a total of only 6 points, instead of 8, between two defensive backs are required to lower the index.

On the Short Pass section of the playing boards the four defensive backs must total only 12, instead of 16, to lower the index.

If you should play NFL teams against AFL teams, the point requirements are unchanged as listed on the boards.

The American Football League provides for two-point conversions after touchdowns. If you want to try for two points, simply declare that you are not kicking and then make the play from the two yard line using the play cards as you would on any regular play from scrimmage.

EB — Flanker Back. Plays offensive halfback, but does not carry ball. Pass receiver only.
PA — used most frequently for punting. PB — also punts.
KA — kicks extra points and field goals. KB — reserve place kicker. KO — usually kicks-off.
OA — returns most kick-offs, place at left halfback position when receiving kick-offs. OB — use at right halfback on kick-offs and at left halfback when OA is injured. OC — also used on kick-off return platoon.
TA — returns most punts, place at left safety position when receiving punts. USE ONLY THESE DESIGNATED PLAYERS IN THE DEEP POSITIONS ON KICKS.
TB — use at right safety on punts and at left safety when TA is injured. TC — also used on punt return platoon.
Use KA or KB for kicking-off unless a KO is specified or if you have a personal choice.
If the player who does the punting or the place-kicking is not a back, he must be placed at the fullback position for the kick play. The quarter-back holds the ball on all place kicks unless he is the kicker, in which case the fullback holds it. On kick-offs the kicker may be at any of the eleven defense positions.
Do not use a player at a position not specified on his card unless injuries make it impossible to field both platoons otherwise. A player may be used on both platoons if necessary or if customary. Defensive backfield players whose cards show no offense position may be used to return punts and kick-offs only if designated kick return men are not available, but not from scrimmage on the offense. They must have specific kick return symbols as shown above of course. Occasionally a player may have a bare offense or defense rating along with a specific position rating. The unspecified rating is used only on those single plays when the player is changed from one platoon to another due to a fumble, interception, etc., or if he is inserted in the lineup to either kick or return a kick.
